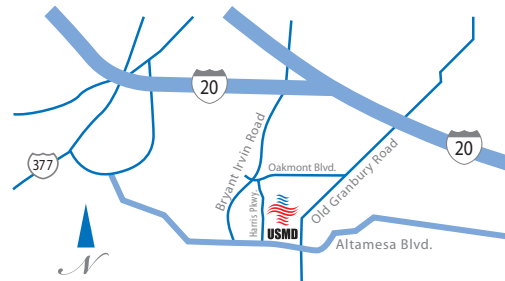

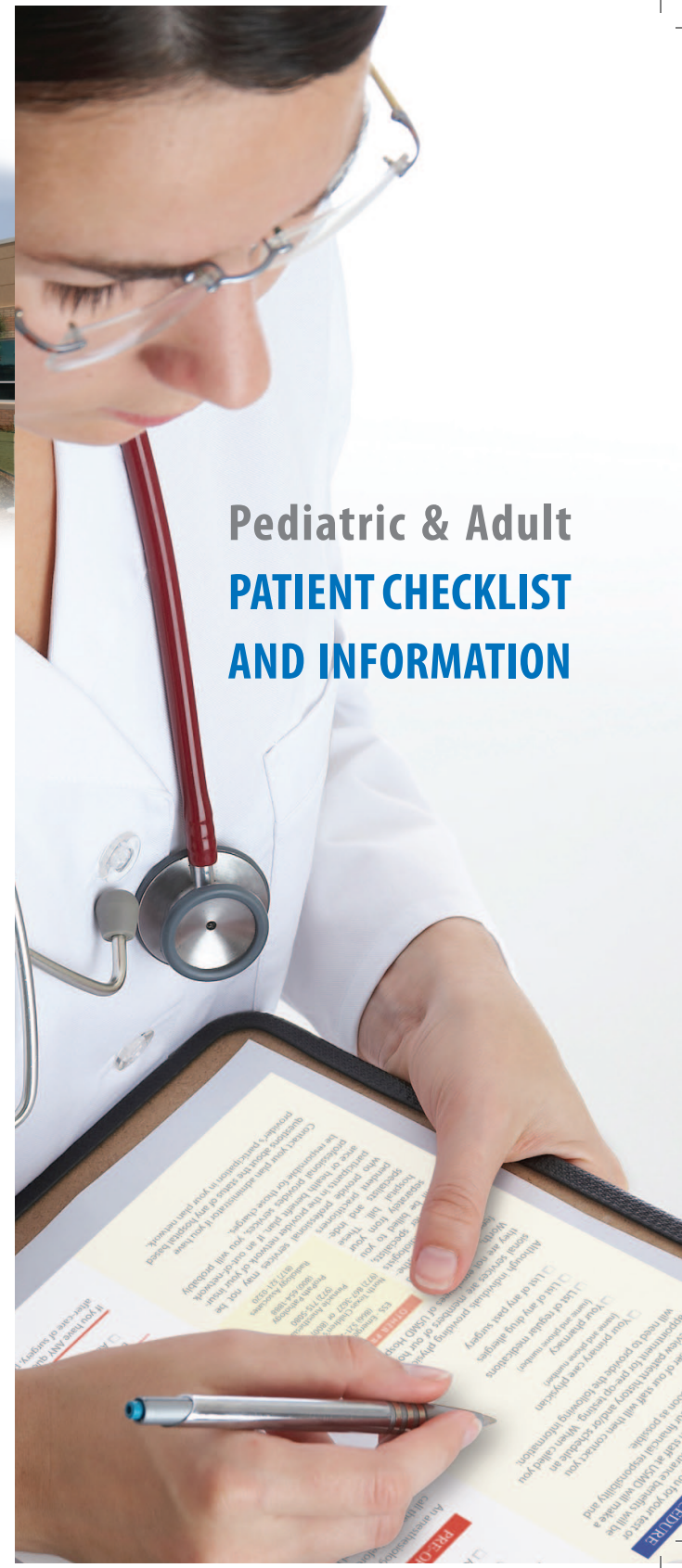

Pediatric & Adult PATIENT CHECKLIST AND INFORMATION

PRE-SURGERY/TEST PROCEDURES

1. After your physician has scheduled your test or surgical procedure, allow us time to verify your insurance benefits. The registration staff at USMD Hospital at Fort Worth, along with your insurance carrier, may determine that you have some financial responsibility for your upcoming procedure. We will contact you as soon as we have that information.

2. A member of our staff will then contact you, or another responsible person or family member, to review your history and schedule an appointment for pre-op testing.

When called, please provide the following information:

- Your primary care physician's name and number
 - Your pharmacy's name and number
 - A list of ALL medications, including any over-the-counter medications
 - A list of any drug allergies
 - A list of any past surgery
 - Describe any serious medical condition
3. Physician members of our staff who provide professional services are not employees of USMD Hospital at Fort Worth. your surgeon, anesthesiologist, radiologist, pathologist and other specialists will bill you or your insurance carrier separately from the hospital.

One of your physician providers may be out-of-network with your insurance carrier. This may result in possible additional charges and financial responsibility to you.

4. Contact your insurance plan administrator, or call the specific provider listed below, if you have any questions regarding the status of any hospital based physician's participation in your insurance plan's network.

Pre-Op Dietary Instructions

5. An anesthesiologist or RN will call you the night before the procedure to explain what you, or your child, may eat or drink prior to surgery. Failure to comply may result in delay or cancellation of your surgery.

If in doubt, do not have anything by mouth after midnight the day before surgery. You may take morning medications with a sip or two of water on the morning of surgery, as mentioned to you by our pre-op nurse.

If you have ANY questions regarding the before or after surgery care, please contact your surgeon.

- Pediatric cases enter at Lighthouse entrance
- Adult cases enter at Clock Tower entrance

If you are unable to keep the appointment for pre-admission testing or surgery, please call (817) 433-9100 to cancel or make further arrangements. Please notify the surgeon of the cancellation as well.

DAY-OF-SURGERY CHECKLISTS

- Shower the morning of surgery (Do not shave the surgical site)
- Do NOT wear make-up to hospital
- Leave all valuables and jewelry at home (including wedding bands and body piercing jewelry)

Please **BRING** the following with you to the hospital:

DOCUMENTATION

- Driver's license
- Insurance card
- Payment (if applicable)
- List of allergies and medications (please bring actual bottles)
- Any special information from the surgeon (e.g., X-rays, consents, orders)
- Copy of advance directives (if applicable) (e.g., a living will or durable power of attorney)
- Legal guardianship papers (if applicable) A parent/guardian must be available to sign all hospital required documents. If we can not verify legal guardianship the procedure will be rescheduled, pending appropriate documents being provided. An interpretation language line is available, if needed).

PERSONAL ITEMS

- Current medications in original bottles (labeled with prescribed dosage)
- Any personal assistive devices (e.g., CPAP, walker, oxygen, inhalers, etc.)
- Contact lens/glasses cases (if applicable)
- Change of clothes, extra diapers, or pull-ups
- Comfort items (e.g., blanket, doll, etc.)

POST-OP

- Wear loose comfortable clothes If surgery will require a large dressing or brace/cast, please wear clothing that will be easy to get on. (The patient may wear his/her own pajamas to the facility, if desired)
- An 18-year or older licensed driver available to drive the patient home (No public transportation or taxis may be used, unless the patient is accompanied by an adult. This will be verified prior to the start of the procedure. If a legal aged driver is not available the procedure may be rescheduled)
- An overnight bag with toiletries (If an overnight stay is required)
